- Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 7:03 pm. Wednesday, May 6, 2015.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

- Dam:** The Dam was checked 05/05/15  
Gate closed  
Water Level -2" (14" down from top of new concrete dock at beach. At MHW level will be 12" below top surface of pier  
Water temperature 62 degrees (9 degree rise past 7 days)  
In flow low – no rain past 23 days  
Weep holes: 1) 10% 2) 10% - both flowing clear  
8 checks 0 adjustments in April
- Water quality:** Clear 3 ½ meters - bottom at dam Slight tinge caused by pollen
- Fishing:** Two fishermen caught and released 100 large and small mouth bass on May 5<sup>th</sup>. Very active especially along shorelines and docks where nesting is beginning. A flock of 8 Bald Eagles seen over lake on week-end. One took a fish from the lake and ate it on a dock on Route 87 side

**Watershed Management:** The LMAC Sub-Committee presented their review of the NAP to date and suggest the following:

- 1) The NAP needs to be a “Stand Alone” document and not incorporated piece meal into other Commissions protocols. Prevent unauthorized revisions and differing interpretations. Everyone refers to the NAP
- 2) Up-date and simplify NAP forms so applicant can do the work, not town employees
- 3) Add some form of exemption list to current building permit NAP requirement to identify those projects that change the flow rate or topography. Identify most obvious exemptions as “By way of example” to avoid trying to identify every possible exemption

Should have a draft proposal ready for the June meeting. Chairman stressed not to rush just to make changes.

**Permit Review:** None

**Old Business:** Several requests to allow permitted work to extend past the March 15<sup>th</sup> deadline due to the protracted ice cover and snow. Chairman recommended not to extend time limit on permits as water is up to the seawalls. Recommends permit extensions
