

**ADOPTION CONCERNING A TWENTY YEAR
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, Section 19-524e of the State of Connecticut General Statutes prescribes that each municipality within the State of Connecticut shall prepare, adopt and enact a twenty year solid waste management plan approved by the Department of Environmental Protection, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Protection has been duly notified in writing of the Town of Columbia's proposal to adopt said twenty year solid waste management plan in its entirety, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Protection has approved and endorsed the adoption of said twenty year solid waste management plan, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Columbia has received written approval of said proposal from the Department of Environmental Protection, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

FIRST: That the twenty year solid waste management plan as prepared by Griswold & Fuss, Inc. be adopted by the Town of Columbia, Connecticut, in pursuance of Section 19-524e of the General Statutes of Connecticut, in said plan's entirety.

SECOND: That any proposed changes to the solid waste management plan which may arise in the future will be submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection for approval prior to incorporation of such changes into the solid waste management plan for the Town of Columbia, Connecticut.

THIRD: That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
