 - Affordable Senior Housing: PZC is reworking the regulations to be more general as "Affordable Housing". It is difficult to have more densely packed affordable housing with dependence on septic and well.

 Storm Drains: Many culverts in Columbia are 50 years or more old and are rusting metal that will be washed away over time they need to be replaced. Storm Drains that lead into Columbia lake are monitored and in the future they may need to be upgraded with a filtering technology prior to water entering the lake
