

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SELECTMEN TO APPOINT
A LIBRARY PLANNING COMMISSION**

There shall be a Library Planning Commission consisting of seven electors of the Town of Columbia who shall be Appointed by the Board of Selectmen and who shall server without compensation. Appointments to the first Commission shall be made within ten days of the effective date of this ordinance. Three members shall be selected from the Saxton B. Little Free Library, Inc. Board of Directors. Of the seven members first appointed, two shall be appointed for a term of two Years; two shall be appointed for three years; and three shall be appointed for a term of four years. Thereafter, all appointments to the Commission shall be for a term of Four Years. Any vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the Board of Selectmen for the unexpired portion of the term.

The Commission shall adopt such rules and regulations as it deems appropriate to govern the conduct of its meetings and the exercise of its powers. The Commission shall elect its own chairperson.

The commission shall study and propose alternate building programs for the development and construction of a Public library. A written report of the proposal s shall be made at the 1982 Annual Town Meeting and thereafter as members deem appropriate. This Commission shall continue until the completed construction of a new library building or an acceptable library building is obtained.
