Household Hazardous Waste Disposal

MidNEROC - Household Chemical Waste Drop-Off Facility

Hazardous materials must be taken to the MidNEROC Household Chemical Waste Drop-Off Facility located on Hancock Road in Willington. There is no charge for the use of this facility by Willington residents, with proof of residency. Business will be charged based on the material type and quantity. Call (860) 965-1910 to make arrangements

- The facility is open 9:00am to 2:00pm the third Saturday of each month from mid-April to early November. For further information, call them at (860) 965-1910. See Schedule for this year below.

How to Prepare Materials:

- Pack carefully in original containers only, sealed and labeled.
- Do not mix materials.
- Place carefully in the car, prevent tipping.
- Drive carefully. Do not smoke while handling and transporting materials.

Limitations:

- Up to 10 gallons liquid (1 gallon or less of each material) and 100 pounds dry material.
 - Bring proof of residency.
 - No commercial users.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED: CREW WILL LEAVE IN YOUR VEHICLE

Loads in excess of 100 lbs. solids or 10 gallons liquids

Oil and Antifreeze (including diesel fuel, brake fluid, transmission fluid, power steering fluids):

Take to your transfer station (Coventry D.P.W.)

Tolland residents: take to Bill's or Anderson Automotive

Any Latex Based Products not taken by Paint Program:

Latex caulk and Sealers

Latex Adhesive

Latex Driveway Sealers

Drywall, Joint Compound, etc.

Spray Paints (Aerosols)

Propane Tanks (your town will take these at the transfer station)

Smoke Detectors

Fertilizers (without pesticides and herbicides)

Pesticides in Sprayers (bring pesticides in original containers)

Asbestos

Driveway Sealers

Fire Extinguishers

Cooking Materials (oil, etc.)

Medicines, Skin Care

Fluorescent Bulbs & Batteries (your transfer station takes these) or (Electronics Recycling Events)

Lead Acid Batteries

Unlabeled Materials, Unknowns

Materials Not Accepted

- Latex Paint
 - Latex paint can be dried out in its can and safely disposed of in the trash or given to someone to use.
- Car Batteries, Used Motor Oil & Anti-freeze
 - Your town recycles these.
- Explosives, Fireworks, Ammunition
 - Contact the Tolland State Police barracks.
- Gas Cylinders - Refillable Type
 - Return to the company that distributed them.
- Wood Preservative containing Penta Chlorophenol
 - There is no known safe way of disposal.
 - Store in leak-proof containers out of reach of children.
- Water Reactive Materials and Chemicals such as peroxides and metallic sodium
 - Contact your local fire marshal for proper disposal.
- Radioactive Materials
 - Contact Connecticut DEP at 424-3372.
- Biologically Active Material
 - Usually pathological matter.
 - Contact Conn. DEP Hazardous Waste Division at 424-3372.
- Medication
 - Usually can be disposed of with trash.
 - Contact Conn. Dept. of Health Services at 566-3186.
- Unknown Material
 - Contact Conn. DEP Waste Bureau at 424-3366.
