COLUMBIA BEACH RULES, as adopted by the Board of Selectmen, July 2009

- INDIVIDUALS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF THEMSELVES AND THEIR CHARGES WHILE AT THE BEACH.
- Children under 5 or weak swimmers must be no more than an arm's length away from a parent or guardian.
- No diving from any of the docks in the swimming area (including flips).
- Swimming outside of the buoyed area is prohibited.
- No floating toys allowed.
- No horseplay (pushing, wrestling, dunking, flips) allowed in or out of the water.
- No smoking or alcoholic beverages allowed in the beach area or parking lots.
- No glass containers are allowed in the beach area.
- No food or drink allowed in the water or on the docks (water bottles are the only exception).
- Access to the water from the lifeguard stands shall not be blocked by blankets, chairs, or toys at anytime.
- Clothing is not to be changed anywhere except in the rest rooms of the Murphy House.
- No animals (except service animals) are allowed past the parking lot.
- Rinsing of diapers or infants in the lake is not allowed. Soiled diapers are to be discarded in a sealed plastic bag.
- Please park in appropriate areas at the Lake, cars are subject to warnings/ticketing if parked incorrectly.
- THE LIFEGUARDS RETAIN THE RIGHT TO SET LIMITS AS NECESSARY AND ARE TO BE OBEYED.
