THE BEGINNING:

Over the past few years, the State of Connecticut, with the help of the Towns of Columbia and Lebanon and the Trust for Public Land, has acquired several large parcels of land. These acquisitions have expanded the Mono Pond State Park from its pre-existing 200 acres to well over 600. The property provides opportunities for hiking, biking, running, and horseback riding; skiing, snowshoeing, and skating; and bow hunting, fishing, and kayaking, to name but a few! The property is also steeped in history, with foundations in the Mint Brook parcel dating back to the 18th century.
