Old Business

o Community Garden 2024 Deb Smith as SFMC garden liaison, and Leslie Brand plot coordinator/garden mentor

- o **Deposit document review** \$30 deposit required. To get deposit back at end of season: 1 hour of communal work per month (6 hours between May-October). individual plot cleanup by November 1st.
- Survey document review: Only 6 of 17 returned (35% response rate). Flooding concerns, Weed control along fence concerns consider more perennials along fence. Need to recruit new gardeners. Need to cover over unused plots with plastic
- o Gardeners at the garden meetings and Facebook sharing: Effective
- Plots still available?: At least 5 maybe more.
- o Rain has caused quite a bit of damage to the gardens from runoff coming down the hill? Is this resolved? There is a pile of wood chips that can be moved to disrupt the water flowing into garden. Potential of moving the weed pile to a different location closer to the barn discussed
- Spring Cleanup of plots and fence lines needs to be done:
- o Hoses: will be put out by the same people that put them away last Fall
- o DPW should turn on water around April 1 this year: Leslie to contact
- Porta Potty is on site for approximately 6 months Should arrive around April 1- will be there until October 15: Leslie to contact
- Improvements needed around gates for rodent control
- Continue perennial planting along the fence perimeter to control weeds
- Other Improvements planned for 2024? Need DPW to cut back encroaching brush and trees
- EO Smith students: Community Service hours by at least 2 students this spring
- Raised Bed: There will be a new small raised bed installed as a trial this year with one gardener (Russ) to try it out. If it works well maybe more to added later.
- Agricultural usage of Ag Units 5 & 6 Jeremy Zurell
 - Soil enhancements application If it dries out application in April
 - Hay Cutting
 - o **Brush Hog** If it dries out perform some over the next several months

- 15 plus -year Anniversary Party for Szegda Farm Community Garden to be show place (last party was 2018 Solstice) – work with Recreation Department to celebrate Open Space in town – Tom will be working with the Rec Department and schedule something

 - Szegda Road Stonewall cleanup and spraying for 2024 yes this will be done again unless we have DPW remove wall. Currently no plan to remove wall. Where would stones go if DPW removed?
