### Instructions for the Use of Yeomans Hall

All users of Yeomans Hall are responsible for leaving the hall in the same condition it was found. Reimbursement for all damages is the responsibility of the person or group using the hall.

- Use only masking tape for decorations (NO nails, staples or other adhesive)
- Secure balloons so they don't get caught in the ceiling fans
- Read posted instructions for the stove prior to use
- Wipe up all spills immediately, using only water
- All furniture set up or moved from its original location must be replaced
- Clean all tables
- Clean kitchen (leave in original condition)
- Dust mop floors
- Dispose of garbage (directions on reverse side)
- Check all bathrooms thoroughly before leaving
  - ♦ Faucets off
  - ♦ Lights off
  - ♦ Toilets flushed
- Turn off
  - ♦ Lights
  - ♦ Ceiling fans
  - ♦ Exhaust fan
- Close inside doors to hall
- Lock all outside doors

## **Cleaning Supply Locations**

- Dust mop, dustpan, broom on the side of the stage
- Dish cloth in kitchen
- > Broom, dustpan, mop & pail are beside the refrigerator in kitchen
- Plunger on side of bathroom
