CALL TO ORDER: S. Everett called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

1. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

4. **AUDIENCE OF CITIZENS:** David Vanderbilt, 213 Rte. 87, West, Columbia, CT. David Vanderbilt asked if the town made their decision on the Invasive Species Abatement project. David Vanderbilt stated he is a member of LMAC and had some concerns about chemically treating the lake to eradicate the Phragmites and that he does not want the lake to be drawn-down too early. He asked if an option could be considered to cut the Phragmites after the lake's drawn-down in September. M. Walter stated that when LMAC meets next, he will ask them to gather all the information and questions for a public meeting. S. Everett thanked Mr. Vanderbilt for his questions and coming to the BOS meeting to share his concerns.

Ann Dunnack, 103 Lake Rd. Columbia, CT. Ann Dunnack asked about an update on the handicap wheel chair that is designed to go on the beach and in the water. Ann stated that one of the issues is if we own one, where we would keep it? S. Everett stated that he would need to get some more information on this.

6.2 Renewal of Columbia’s 3-year agreement with CIRMA for WC/LAP. M. Walter stated that there was a 0% increase on both the LAP and WC Rates. He added that because we hold regular safety meetings to actively reduce our exposure and that we do not have our own police department, these factors contribute to our low rates. W. O’Brien asked if there were other competitors than CIRMA. M. Walter stated that CIRMA has remained steady and is the most competitive in regard to municipalities as opposed to other competitors who have not stayed consistently within the municipal insurance market. W. O’Brien MOVED that we renew Columbia’s 3-year agreement with CIRMA for WC/LAP. MOTION CARRIED 4.0.

In accordance with Connecticut General Statute 12-165 the suspense list is being submitted for approval. There are six accounts on the Personal Property list and all others are Motor Vehicle bills. These accounts are removed from consideration as assets for the Town of Columbia. This keeps the collectible reporting as accurate as possible. These taxes are not abated and we do collect accounts on the suspense list each year.

You will see that some of the accounts had Alias Tax Warrants issued for collection by the State Marshal and were returned by the State Marshal unsatisfied. For those with motor vehicle bills and who stay in Connecticut and eventually need to register a vehicle, they will have to pay the tax, interest and fees before they receive clearance from the Town of Columbia.

Columbia Rec Park plan meets opposition

COLUMBIA — A plan to improve Recreation Park facilities concerned some who attended a public hearing on the proposed 2018-19 budget Wednesday, with residents feeling it is not an appropriate time to invest in such a project.

The proposed 2018-19 town/school combined spending plan is \$18,384,542, a decrease of \$505,145, or 2.67 percent, from the current spending plan.

Residents will vote on the budget during an annual town meeting on May 15.

Residents will vote on the budget during an annual town budget meeting May 15 at 7 p.m. at Yeomans Hall.

During the public hearing at Yeomans Hall, Columbia Town Administrator Mark Walter said the proposed budget involves a proposition that \$400,000 be used from the general fund to offset the mill rate.

Under the proposed budget, the mill rate would be 29.91, an increase of 1.03 mills over the current mill rate.

For a home assessed at \$200,000, that entails a \$206 increase in taxes.

"This budget that FiPAC (financial planning and allocation commission), the board of (education) and board of selectmen have put together is very conservative," said Walter.

The town/school combined spending plan takes into account a \$825,580 reduction in intergovern-

mental revenues, including state and federal funding, with the town projected to receive \$2,412,643 in 2018-19.

The town/school combined spending plan includes:

- A capital fund budget of \$895,303, a decrease of \$179,045, or 16.67 percent, from the current budget.

The capital fund includes \$195,000 in funds annually for five years, beginning in 2018-19, for the first phase of a Recreation Park improvement plan, which includes plans to upgrade the athletic fields at the park, which is off Hennequin Road.

According to town officials, the plan is to focus on the first of three phases of the project for now.

Resident Paul Kubala, however, said he felt once the town started spending \$195,000 a year, it would not "stop the project."

FiPAC Chairman Earnest Sharpe said FiPAC had similar concerns and requested a presentation about the project be given to the public, as was done April 19.

"The master plan for Rec Park started probably three years ago and there have been multiple meetings," said former first selectman Carmen Vance. "This is not something someone dreamed up in the last six months."

Kubala said he "hated" being told to pay attention to what was going on in town.

"I pay attention, more so than the average person in this town does," he said.

- A board of education

budget of \$12,610,633, a decrease of \$283,736, or 2.2 percent, from the current budget.

The proposed budget includes \$2,155,100 allocated for the Education Cost Sharing Grant, a state grant, a reduction of \$406,339, or 15.86 percent, from the current budget.

While several new programs are being introduced, the proposed budget does not include any additional staff.

"What we've done is we've been able to reassign staff as openings occurred over the last few years," said Columbia Superintendent of Schools Laurence "Loi" Fearon.

New initiatives include offering French as a pilot for seventh-graders and a program through Project

Oceanology, a marine science educational organization in Groton, for students in grades 5 through 8.

- A board of selectmen budget of \$3,914,627, an increase of \$92,295, or 2.41 percent, from the current budget.

- \$78,000 for contingency funds, an increase of \$33,000, or 73.33 percent, from the current budget.

- \$166,750 for debt service, a decrease of \$7,250, or 4.17 percent, from the current budget. In addition, there are small amounts included for miscellaneous funds in the budget.
