NOTIFICATION OF AQUATIC TREATMENT COLUMBIA LAKE - COLUMBIA, CT

In accordance with the Connecticut DEEP, Pesticide Division notification requirements, Columbia Lake in Columbia, CT will be chemically treated with USEPA/ CT DEEP registered herbicides to control nuisance aquatic vegetation on Wednesday, October 7, 2020 with a Rain date of Thursday, October 8, 2020. Only the non-native Phragmites (common reed) around the shoreline will be treated with Clearcast (Imazamox). There are no labeled water use restrictions required for this treatment however entry into any Phragmites areas around the lake should be avoided on the day of treatment. Prior to treatment, the lake shoreline will be posted with signs near any treatment areas warning of these temporary use restrictions.

This work is being performed for the Town of Columbia. Treatments are conducted pursuant to the permit issued by the CT DEEP.
