The Governing Body of the Town of Columbia declares there is a shortage of safe or sanitary dwellings in this Municipality available to low income families at rentals they can afford; and there is a need for, and it is desirable and in the public interest for the Commissioner of community Affairs to administer a program of rental housing assistance under Section 8 of Title 11 of the United States Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383) and in accordance with Section 8-120, and chapters 128, 129 and 133, of the Connecticut General Statutes as amended. We hereby, approve the operation of the said rental assistance program in this municipality by the said Commissioner. This resolution is passed at the request of the Hartford area office of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
