

**ORDINANCE CONCERNING APPROVAL OF SEWERAGE FACILITIES
IN THE TOWN OF COLUMBIA**

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Section 1. No dwellings, apartments, boarding houses, hotels, commercial buildings or commercial camps and commercial camping facilities shall be constructed In the Town Of Columbia unless the sewerage facilities in connection with the same have been approved By the Director of Health of the Town or an inspector appointed by him with the approval of The Selectmen. The Director of Health, or any Inspector appointed by him shall approve any such sewerage facilities when such facilities meet the requirements of the Public Health Code of the State of Connecticut.

Section 2. All applications for approval of sewerage facilities shall be filed with the Director of Health or the inspector appointed by him. All applications for approval shall be accompanied by a plan of the proposed sewerage facilities. The fee, which shall be established by the Board of Selectmen. Said fee shall be payable to the Town of Columbia.

Section 3. The owner or agent of any building who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for each and every day that such violation shall continue.
