

**PURCHASE OF SANITARY DISPOSAL AREA ON ROUTE 6**

Town Record Book 5 Page 350

VOTED that the Town purchase 20.4 acres, more or less, on Route 6; for use as a sanitary disposal area, at the cost of \$37,100.00 to be taken from the reserve fund for capital and nonrecurring expenditures, and \$4,000 from the surplus to complete the purchase.

VOTED that the purchase of this sanitary landfill be made subject to the following stipulations, details to be arranged by Town Counsel and Town Selectmen:

1. That the landfill operations be not closer than 150 feet from the Hop River or its associated wetlands, as so designated by the appropriate soil and streambelt maps of the U.S. Soil Conservation Service.

VOTED that the Town appropriate, from surplus, the sum of \$5,000.00 for the purpose of preliminary development and preparation of the sanitary disposal area. If said funds are necessary to be used before the beginning of the new fiscal year.
