

REFERENDUM ON PURCHASE OF MURPHY PROPERTY

A referendum vote of electors and citizens qualified to vote in Town Meeting in the Town of Columbia will be held in said Town of Columbia on the 5th day of March 1990 in the following polling place: the Donald R. Tuttle gymnasium at the Horace W. Porter School, Schoolhouse Lane, Columbia, Connecticut between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. to vote on the following question.

"Shall the Town purchase the Murphy property, 18 Lake Road., for \$315,000 and appropriate from the Capital Project Reserved for Land \$175,000 payable by 4/28/90, and appropriate for 1990-91 \$140,000 from the General Fund and unallocated funds in the reserve fund payable 7/15/90?"

Voters approving said question shall vote "YES" and those opposing said question shall vote "NO".
